### **'CBS Evening News': The Canadian lawyer is an "American Political Icon" and the Coalition Threatens to Rendition Chinada Operatives "For Years"**

[May 17, '08]

At the top of the May 17, 2008 broadcast, Russell executed a combination Thalia – **triple** Harry M. to "American political icon" – publicly referring to Senator Kennedy and geo-politically referring to the Canadian lawyer. The purpose was to keep his international persona at its pinnacle.

Later during an intro on Guantanamo Bay he executed a **triple** Harry M. to "American authorities are expecting to hold terrorist suspects for years to come", which underscored plans of renditioning members of the China-Canada military alliance to contain and neutralize the threat they pose.

He added a Condi M. to "[X] has suffered membership losses", which was as much to add to the rendition threat as it was to articulate that there could be casualties when the use of armed force encounters resistance during covert regime change.

And his brief remarks on an up-coming horse race was also multi-tasked, adding two more Condi M.s to "[X] is on track to win...", referring to the Canadian lawyer and coalition's defeat of a territory expanding fiefdom-totalitarian commu-nazi genocidal racism paradigm of governance and the democratization of the Canadian state.

### **'CBS Evening News': Powerful Coercive Diplomacy, a "Tip of the Iceberg" Reference and Acknowledging the Pros and Cons of Constitutionally Limited Office**

[January 9, '08]

During the January 9, 2008 newscast Katie executed a Blair M. during her same-day interview with Senator Clinton, timed to the question "How can you be a real change agent with a two term limit?". The question is in political theory relevant to Canada, since prime ministers can hold the highest offices as long as his or her party continues to win elections. The pro is that public interest minded leaders can do a whole lot of good for a country during a long tenure. The con is that, like in Canada, lengthy terms breed non-democratic practices.

There were two Couric-Wolf M.s. The first was motivated by coercive diplomacy: "It was a horrific scene this morning; four people died [in the highway traffic accident]".

The second was timed to “tip of the iceberg” – which is a phrase that was used in the cover letter to all *Fiefdom* treatise recipients to describe several instances of government malfeasance which demonstrated that below the public radar screen there was everything itemized in the *Fiefdom* indictment.

### **‘CBS Evening News’: Multiple Geo-Topics and Communiqués**

[December 23, ‘07]

Likely due to the increased coalition activity at the end of the third week of December 2007, the broadcast on the 23rd contained quite a few topics and communiqués from the following CBS correspondents:

- the conflict between the U.S. and Canada has been building for years and will be resolved in favor of democracy and a China-free country – Sandra’s Blair M. timed to “[X] has been building for years” in her housing slump segment;
  - the China-Canada military alliance is out-gunned – Joie timed a Senator executing an Olmert-Spielberg M. to “party leaders conceded they were outgunned” during presidential campaign segment;
  - the coalition has the perfect Christmas gift for the Canadian lawyer – anchoring Randall introducing a holiday shopping segment stating “shoppers are scouring store shelves for the [O-S M.] perfect present;
  - “peace on earth is as remote as ever” [given Chinada’s warmongering] – Scott’s series interviewing three experts intro-ed by Randall who executes Fredricka M. to the quote;
  - not stopping Chinada will embolden other rogue states – Scott executes Prince Harry M. to expert’s remark “If we don’t stop the demise of the tiger we won’t stop the demise of [other animals]”; and
  - helping the Canadian lawyer realize his dreams – during Thalia’s segment on soldier musicians she inserted a clip of a recording engineer execute a George W. M. to “Now [X] is realizing a dream”.

### **‘CBS Evening News’: A Very Clever and Extremely Potent Depiction of Canada’s Malfeasant Standing Before the ‘Iron Fist’ Adjudicator**

[December 7, ‘07]

One can almost hear the chuckles emanating from the CBS office when a producer came up with the idea of how to send another prison certainty communiqué to Canada’s incorrigibly corrupt and enthusiastic warmongers.

Barry Bonds rose to international stardom, it is alleged, by using performance enhancing drugs; and then lied during an grand jury investigation into the use of steroids in professional baseball. He’s been charged with perjury and obstruction of

justice. When he appeared in court on December 7, 2007, the CBS news graphic artist attended and drew him addressing the judge. In John Blackstone's segment the East-West audience saw the accused's arm extended and grasping the microphone; a Bernanke M.. Now *that's* clever.

**'CBS Evening News': Elevating the Canadian lawyer's International Persona Again and Confirming a Coalition-Procured Crackdown on Lawlessness in Canada**

[November 29, '07]

CBS news producers found another couple ways to keep the Canadian lawyer's international persona on the East-West Corridor of Diplomacy marquee. During the intro to the November 29, 2007 broadcast, Katie executed a double-handed 60 Minutes M. and Shania M. to "the world's most wanted...".

Katie also executed a Couric-Wolf M. to the word "crackdown" – articulating that when the coalition is ready to move it will endeavor to reduce the rampant lawlessness that exists throughout Canada to perpetuate the internationally condemned paradigm of governance and China's militarization.

**'CBS Evening News': The Geo-Political Conflict is an "International Battle"**

[November 28, '07]

During the November 28, 2007 newscast Katie's Couric-Wolf M. was timed to "international battle" – an apt way of describing the conflict between the China-Canada military alliance and the coalition; which is now comprised of nations from all regions of the world.

**'CBS Evening News': Another Communiqué the Coalition is Going to Become More Aggressive Given Canada's Leadership – Some of Whom are Under Federal U.S. Indictment, Chinada Looking for a Fight and the Canadian lawyer Ought to Wear His Predicament Like a Badge of Honor**

[November 26, '07]

On November 26, 2007, CBS news producers continued delivering communiqués to the East-West Corridor of Diplomacy. The first segment involved Katie sitting down with Senator Hillary Clinton for an interview and then later in the editing room splicing the film to generate the messages documented in the chapter title:

Katie: [voiceover] I talked one-on-one today [Diaz M.] with Hillary Clinton and I asked her about her new more aggressive tone [Atkinson M.] of her campaign.

[...]

Hillary: I have absorbed a lot of attacks for several months now. My opponents have basically had a free reign. I've tried to bring democrats together; talk about where we are different from Republicans; the Republicans have attacked me as well; which I think is also a [clip: Katie: Maria M.] badge of honor.

There were also two segments on the presidential campaign; part of one dealing with the barbs being fired between Mitt Romney and Rudy Giuliani about the appointments each made when in office. A clip of the latter's former police commissioner executing a Bush M. was timed to the phrase "federal indictment", which corroborates the Canadian lawyer's assertion that some of Canada's leaders and their financiers and followers violated U.S. law in seeking to help their Canadian business and Beijing with its illegal foreign policy and for which they will be held to account either before, after or as part of the coalition's 'Iron Fist' prosecutions.

Another included a clip of former Senator Edwards executing an SNL M. timed to "he's a man looking for a fight", which is what the China-Canada military alliance and Canada's America-hating trans-generationally corrupt are doing – one everyone but them knows they're going to lose big-time.

**'CBS Evening News': Telling Canada's Three Sub-Factions Chain Gang Detail Will Include Garbage Collection to Beautify the Country They Sought to Secretly Trash**

[October 4, '07]

There are still new themes that can be articulated relevant to the Chinada problem and how it is to be resolved. CBS producers articulated one on October 4, 2007. Katie (prison certainty) executed a Thalia M. to introduce a segment on a group of Americans who gave up their high paying jobs to engage in environmental clean-up. The communiqué ratified the Canadian lawyer's belief those not imprisoned will be living a 'dumpster-diver' lifestyle for their complicity and loyalty.

[Thalia M.] They left great jobs in corporate America for a new career – picking up the trash.

There were other coalition initiatives. Kelly filed a report on seafood consumption and pregnancy. Her being in bold prison certainty with a belly out to "here" generated a communiqué related to the isolation-deprivation issue about the Canadian lawyer being deprived of having a family of his own so he could be the penultimate lab monkey in perpetuity.

And Katie executed a 60 Minutes M. to introduce a segment on the presidential candidates; which was multi-tasked to describe how all of Canada's accountability mechanisms are structured to protect the country's three sub-factions – publicly

referred by her as how the candidates “have been reluctant to go after one another”.

**‘CBS Evening News’ High Profiling the Canadian lawyer’s Enslavement and Linking it to Coercive Diplomacy**

[September 12, ‘07]

This time CBS producers intentionally prepared a special interests story on human trafficking and inserted instances of Dogville-style coercive diplomacy – since the China-Canada military alliance did something parallel to the Canadian lawyer when enslaving him into a life as a human experimentation victim.

**‘CBS Evening News’ and the ‘NBC Nightly News’: “The Whitehouse to the Rescue” Leaving Chinada “Very Worried”**

[August 31, ‘07]

Historians will look back and marvel at how much pressure CBS and NBC put on Canada’s leadership and Beijing’s military assets in the country. Day after week after month for over a year and a half the two networks pounded them with a barrage of non-stop demands to capitulate or face serious consequences. That ‘hold no punches’ attitude was again observed on August 31, 2007.

**‘CBS Evening News’: “[Canada] as a Whole [is] a Nightmare” and Lara’s Brilliant Prison Certainty Imbued Segment**

[September 4, ‘07]

Somethin’ must be brewin’ in the coalition for there to be such an aggressive and threatening set of communiqués. Throughout the last week of August and the first couple days of September coalition content was so amazingly assertive, a decision to accelerate demobilization must have been made. Therefore, what was witnessed on September 4, 2007 was a prelude to what Canada’s three sub-factions still don’t believe will occur.

**‘CBS Evening News’ More Coercive Diplomacy and Very Shortly the Coalition’s Military Will “Walk the Streets of [Canada]”**

[September 3, ‘07]

On September 3, 2007, Labor Day, CBS producers filled the newscast with more communiqués; seeking to maintain the ubiquity of condemnation and again insisting there will be a military intervention and the malfasant will face international justice.

Not only did the President and his Secretaries of Defense and State fly to Iraq for a surprise visit, Katie went to spend a week there, seemingly taking Lara's place to be in harm's way on behalf of both CBS' audience and the coalition partnership.

Her aggressively executed Pfeiffer M. when strolling with military personnel and members of the CBS team – timed to her voiceover “as we walk the streets of Falluga” – was scripted to convey the message that in short order coalition forces will be doing the same on the streets of Canada's major cities; principally Dogville, Toronto, Montreal and Ottawa. For corroborative measure, her gesture was timed at the start of the remark with her companion's quasi-Clooney M., timed to make it unconstestably clear the coalition intends on using military assets to achieve the coalition's three primary objectives.

There was even more corroboration this was the communiqué of the day. During the segment on the hurricane bearing down on Mexico, the meteorologist executed two Mary M.s to “it looks like it's going to make landfall”.

With the evidence in that Canada's three sub-factions are suffering some kind of cognitive dysfunctionality, viewed in the *Fiefdom* treatise as a clinical form of sociopathology, Dr. Lapook's segment on children with psychiatric problems included a Redstone-Moonves M..

There were three instances of coercive diplomacy during the Labor day newscast. The first was embedded in a caption rendered in Canada colors: “Warehouse Explosion”.

The second was during Kelly's segment on five so-called spies from Cuba who've been in jail for years waiting to get their names cleared. During Kelly's interview of a man, she executed an Erin M. to “the Cuban [X] are murderers”, which was the coalition's way of reminding of the *Fiefdom* indictment against Canada's elite for depraved indifference murder and economic genocide. And then she executed an Olmert-Spielberg M. to “real violence against...”, which was CBS communicating for coalition partners what Canada's incorrigibly corrupt and belligerent can look forward to if they should resist arrest, prosecution, incarceration and asset seizure.

The third element of coercive diplomacy had a Kidmanesque flavor. It came during the last segment of the newscast – Katie's second of two reports from Iraq. During it she sat down with an Iraqi woman who was choreographed to be the unwitting spokesperson for a very serious threat:

I think they will kill all the people [Prince Harry M.]. I can't stay hone alone  
– maybe they will kill me.

There was one other coalition inspired initiative. Britain announced on this Labor Day it was breaking a 522 year old glass ceiling for women. The Beefeaters, the Royal Family's prison guard regiment, had welcomed its first woman into the ranks. To multi-task the story into another communiqué that imprisonment is inevitable,

Russell executed a Thalia M. to "her role includes giving tours of the Tower [of London]".

All in all, there was again absolutely no doubt the coalition is going to steam roller right over any resistance it encounters on its way to democratization.

**'CBS Evening News': More Coercive Diplomacy, High Profiling Isolation-Deprivation and Recommending Democracy-Minded Canadian Officials to Distance Themselves from the Malfasant**

[August 29, '07]

CBS news producers bootstrapped a day-old story about a sex scandal involving a U.S. Senator to recommend that Canadian officials on the democracy side of the Chinese Wall distance themselves from members of trans-generational corruption and the China-Canada military alliance and do what they could to force the resignation of the complicit.

Katie began the newscast during the preview and intro with:

[60 MM] The scandal in the Senate. [...] [Thalia M., Bl.M.] Last week most Americans had never even heard of Senator [X]. But the Idaho Republican finds himself at the center of a growing scandal that began with a sting [operation ...] earlier this summer. It didn't take long for prominent members of his own party to distance themselves and pressure him to quit his senior committee post.

**'CBS Evening News': "Saluting" the Canadian lawyer, "One of the Most Powerful and Influential Men in Washington"**

[August 13, '07]

Through the CBS news conduit the coalition didn't mince words on August 13, 2007 when describing the Canadian lawyer's international reputation and clout.

Katie began the broadcast with the second phrase in the chapter title and attached both a 60 Minutes M. and a coalition-identifying and corroborating **three** Harry M.s to make sure nobody in the East-West Corridor of Diplomacy missed or mistook the geo-political sentiment behind multi-tasking the second quote in the chapter title.

The first quote came at the end of the newscast and was red flagged with a Couric-Wolf M..

## **'CBS Evening News': Getting Militarily Aggressive on 8.8.07**

[August 8, '07]

By early August 2007 it must be all too evident to the coalition that the only way to achieve its three primary objectives for Canada is to militarily intervene. All attempts at peaceful diplomacy not only failed but also procured a non-stop barrage of the most insolent of responses from the Canada's malfasant.

During the August 8th newscast, Katie, attired in punishment certainty, executed a 60 Minutes M. to "Getting closer to those six trapped miners...", a way to draw a parallel between the victims of a cave-in and the predicament the Canadian lawyer's found himself in for so long.

What gave a military intervention aspect to the communiqués on the day the Chinese hold as the luckiest on the calendar was the Pentagon and Department of Defense arranging for a member of the **Third** Infantry to be filmed in front of its logo – prison certainty (justice).

Later a segment got Kidmanesque. It was about returning soldiers; and included a clip from the battlefield in which a soldier stated they had a "**38** minute firefight – **twenty** insurgents killed".

## **'CBS Evening News': Again Drawing a Parallel Between Radical Islamist Fundamentalism and the China-Canada Military Alliance, "Closing a Painful Chapter" and "Tinkering With Nature"**

[July 17, '07]

There was no escaping the major and serious implication of coalition content during the July 17, 2007 broadcast of the CBS news. There was Katie's intro and the corruption gestured interview with Homeland Secretary Michael Chertoff.

She began with a **triple** gesture: a Thalia, 60 Minutes and Blair M. to:

Nearly six years after the 9/11 attacks al-Qaeda is still determined to strike us again.

Then there was a clip from the morning interview involving a Homeland Security advisor (attired in punishment certainty); followed by a caption in which "Homeland Security" was rendered in the colors of China.

All that was followed by an exclusive interview with the Homeland Secretary and in which an employee sitting behind Katie on the CBS set executed a George W. M. as follows during the Secretary's response to Katie's question:

Just as we've devoted a lot of energy to increasing our defenses, they haven't been standing still. They've learned lessons – observing what we've

done. And as they continue to grow [Geo W. M.] and they morph, the stretch into places like Europe, North Africa and East Africa.

This is a dynamic situation. It's a long war and it's one in which we cannot afford to rest on our laurels because, I will tell you, the enemy is not resting on its laurels.

**'CBS Evening News': "The Largest Settlement Ever" From "The Biggest Scandal Ever" and Five References to the Number Eight**

[July 16, '07]

On the heels of the largest infrastructure cancellation in Canada's oil patch in history – the Gateway pipeline from Fort MacMurray to the west coast, CBS producers pounded the malfasant with more condemnation on July 16, 2007.

To drive home China was in the coalition sights, there were **five** references to the number **eight**:

- (i) 80+ killed in Iraq;
- (ii) 180+ wounded in Iraq;
- (iii) \$80 million Democrats raised for the election (\$50 million Republicans);
- (iv) at least 8 killed Japanese earthquake;
- (v) 8% of CEOs have substance abuse problems.

The mood got Kidmanesque when Katie executed a big 60 Minutes M. to "In Denver today security guards shot dead a man [who went to the Governor's office, claimed he was Emperor and said he was taking over the government]". The Geo-gesture turned that by-line into a direct threat of military action against those who continue to resist implementing the primary demands of the international community.

**'CBS Evening News': Here Comes "A Big Defeat" Because Canada's Governments Lost the Coalition's 'Vote of Confidence'**

[June 11, '07]

The June 11, 2007 newscast was not only filled with the love and affection of an 'always in harm's way' Lara Logan but also several other coalition initiatives.

There cannot be any ambiguity in Katie's 60 Minutes -flagged opening remark: "A big defeat". Nor was there any doubt what the "War on Terror" caption rendered in China colors was referencing.

And she executed another 60 Minutes M. to "vote of no confidence", which was a news headline about a Senate resolution and which had geo-political ramifications

with respect to the legitimacy of Canada's three levels of government. Without legitimacy there's no sovereignty.

**'CBS Evening News': A Multitude of Communiqués to the Audience in the East-West Corridor of Diplomacy**

[June 6, '07]

By Wednesday, June 6, 2007 it was evident that there was so much coalition activity because it was G8 week. As with previous international conferences where world leaders gathered, the coalition community unleashed a barrage of initiatives to intensify the pressure on the malfeasant to prepare to be purged and punished. The CBS News on Wednesday was a clear indication of that increased activity.

Where there are usually a few uses of the diplomatic lexicon during the CBS newscast, on this day there were ten. The broadcast began with Katie in prison certainty and executing two 60 Minutes M.s: one to "exploded on Capitol Hill" – emphasis on the coercive diplomacy.

During Richard's segment acknowledging the sixty-third anniversary of the day that changed the course of World War II by the amassing of a most amazing coalition of allied forces, producers chose a clip of one of the marine troop carriers because the number painted on the sign contained a *quantum* ratifier and a double China identifier: "**588**".

**'CBS Evening News': "Counting Heavily on" the Canadian lawyer to Achieve Coalition Objectives**

[May 20, '07]

CBS news executives and producers had four specific messages to deliver to the East-West Corridor of Diplomacy on Sunday, May 20, 2007.

[...]

The third was another 60 Minute M. red flagged remark. Russell's "counting heavily on..." was directed at the Canadian lawyer and conveying the sentiment that coalition partners have put a lot of faith in his knowledge, talents, skills and abilities to achieve objectives in Canada.

## **'CBS Evening News': Military Strikes Imminent**

[May 19, '07]

Sumner's CBS asset continued his full court press approach to 'capitulate or suffer' dynamic on May 19, 2007. There were several coalition initiatives interspersed throughout the newscast.

[...]

The next was a very aggressive communiqué that Canada's elite ought to prepare for military strikes. A Condi M. was executed by a new anchor to "Israel launched new air strikes...".

## **'CBS Evening News': Mark Their Words: Canada's Leadership is Going to Get a Lesson from the Coalition They'll Never Forget or Recover From**

[April 10, '07]

Time and time and time again the coalition has been trying to move Canada's political leaders and wealthy to reason; and all they get back is belligerence, extreme insolence and threatening their Canadian representative with death and grievous bodily injury; and who torture and harass him constantly. Since they won't stand down their illegalities, they're going to be forced to stop. As a punishment certainty attired Katie began Sumner's umpteenth multi-tasked broadcast on April 10, 2007, she articulated with a quasi-Blair M. what the coalition news headline is going to be one day:

This country got a lesson today.

## **'CBS Evening News': Confirmation the Coalition's Going to "Kick Start" Democratization**

[April 7, '07]

The coalition confirmed on April 7, 2008 during the CBS news that it fully intends on taking all reasonable steps to turn Canada into a healthy democracy and evict Chinese military assets.

Not only did coalition partners affirm this objective but again identified the synergy between them and the Dogville situate Canadian lawyer when CBS producers created a caption that used a phrase that's been employed multiple times in the *Fiefdom* treatise: "Kick Start". While it was inserted in a preview of a special interest story on professional soccer, it was clearly chosen to send a message to the incorrigibly corrupt their days are numbered governing the country federally, provincially and municipally.

That wasn't the only coalition initiative of the broadcast. The caption "Battle for Iraq" was rendered in Canadian colors. Allen's segment summarizing his tour of Iraq included a clip of a little boy executing a Clooney M. and timed it to the word "deceptive", which is an accurate way to describe the democracy façade manufacture part of the Canadian elite's paradigm of governance.

### **'CBS Evening News' Elevates Canadian Lawyer to "Literary Legend" Status**

[April 12, '07]

Coalition partners again reasserted their high regard for the *Fiefdom* treatise author on April 12, 2007. During the CBS News the reporting of the passing of an American writer was multi-tasked, seeking to elevate the Canadian lawyer to the pinnacle of critical acclaim for his ongoing work for them on the geo-political conflict between the U.S., China and Canada.

A punishment certainty attired Katie could executed a Couric-Wolf M. timed to "remembering a literary legend".

On the last day of February 2007, CBS news again proved to be a most critical conduit for the coalition. Katie wore the unmistakable colors of the President's *quantum* and while so attired executed **three** Geo-gestures – two Blair M.s and a Couric-Wolf M. – timed to the following remarks:

...can correct defects...

...making great strides.

And still ahead [the secret] to getting everything you want.

The first was a coalition affirmation that on the macro level it will help kick start democracy and on the micro level fix the Canadian lawyer's life by helping him out of the twenty year hell hole of experimentation, enslavement, impoverishment, imprisonment, isolation, deprivation, torture and ubiquitous stupidity and securing his *quantum* and a circle of trusted friends and associates.

The second was confirmation that coalition objectives were closer than ever to being achieved.

And the third, red flagged by the isolation-deprivation gesture, was to remind him that his desire for love, romance, intimacy, relationships, sexuality and family creation dynamics is going to be taken care of.

Thus his 'three wishes' are going to come true: (i) a democratic Canada, (ii) compensation and the damages that accumulated pursuant to the *quantum* increase schedule\* and (iii) companionship with coalition members.

[February 27, '07]

On Tuesday, February 27, 2007, the first diplomatic embeds were inserted right at the top of the broadcast.

Attired in the color of justice, Katie began with the following and red flagged it with a quasi-Blair M.:

Hello everyone. We haven't [Bl.M.] seen a day like this on Wall Street in years.

She was referring to the stock market collapse of historic proportions and thus by extension was affirming the end of imperialistic fiefdom-totalitarian commu-nazi genocidal racism.

Then CBS producers instructed two assistants sitting at the back of the studio – one attired in punishment certainty and another in condemnation – to execute gestures timed to:

No one is closer to the action at the stock market than Art Cashin. He's the head floor trader for financial giant UBS.

Finally, the last lexiconic embed was during Katie's intro about a U.S. soldier who did something special for an Iraqi boy before being killed in the war. She executed a very 'loud' Blair M. to high profile the Canadian lawyer's international persona, timed to:

Coming up next [Bl.M.] an American hero who saved a little boy's life.

## **'CBS Evening News': Emphasizing the 'Nazi' in Enslaving Torturous Human MK-Ultra Experimentation**

[February 18, '07]

The last segment on the February 18, 2007 broadcast of the CBS news was about the Jewish girl Anne Frank who died in a concentration camp with most of her family and whose diary became an international sensation. Producers multi-tasked the special interest story to draw a parallel between the Hitlerian paradigm of governance and Chinada's.

The subject-matter of the report was revealing new evidence that her father almost escaped Germany – missing his and his family's chance by only a few days. The interviewed archivist was wardrobe first to wear a red sweater and a black and white vertically striped dress (Canadian prison certainty) and then the color of justice. A parallel was being drawn between her documenting her time in Nazi-occupied Amsterdam and the Canadian's *Fiefdom* treatise, which has become a daily diary of his experiences in Beijing-occupied Dogville.

And there were more diplomatic embeds. For example, the first caption "Battle for Iraq" was rendered in Chinada colors and included a cross-hairs graphic – clearly a Dogville theme.

## **'CBS Evening News': There's No Way Around the Military Intervention and the 'Iron Fist' Accountability Mechanism**

[February 1, '07]

Katie's opening script to the February 1, 2007 broadcast included executing a Blair M.. She stated "There's no way around it" – meaning the democratization of Canada, accountability and the eviction of the Chinese military.

There was a lot of coalition activity in the CBS News on the first anniversary of U.S. troops shooting at Canada's diplomats in Baghdad's Green Zone to send a message to the incoming Prime Minister he'd better comply with what were then 'requests' of the international community. It began with the Blair M. premised opening words of Katie's script: "There's no way around it", meaning if Canada's elite don't fully capitulate, they're going to face justice and the country they've raped, pillaged, plundered and terrorized is going to be democratized.

## **'CBS Evening News': Identifying the Value Inherent in the Canadian Lawyer's Knowledge, Skills and Talents**

[December 28, '06]

During the December 28, 2006 broadcast of the CBS News, Allan executed an intentionally visible and protracted Blair M. timed to the remark "skills ... were so

highly prized". That was along the same lines as Russell's December 22nd use of a Blair M. timed to the phrase "expert opinions" – meant to identify the Canadian lawyer as producing credible views on the subjects which he opines on for the coalition.

These compliments come after the *Fiefdom* treatise made dozens of important discoveries and academic and legal arguments about Canada, about China, about the leaderships of both nations and their secret military alliance and its objectives.

**'CBS Evening News': Confirming Members of the Trans-Generational Corrupt and Chinese Face a Dogville Fate**

**'CBS Evening News': How the Coalition Acknowledged the British Columbia Premier's Confession of Beijing Loyalty and International and Canadian Domestic Law Violations**

The *Fiefdom* treatise author produced a chapter on Thursday, December 14, 2006 on the confession the Canadian lawyer heard made by the British Columbia Premier, Gordon Campbell, regarding his involvement and complicity in the charges made in the *Fiefdom* criminal indictment: *The Premier of British Columbia Confesses to Maintaining the China-Canada Military Alliance*.

Seventeen days after the Canadian lawyer stood right in front of the internationally disgraced Premier and conspicuously stared him down on Remembrance Day for fifteen minutes to deliver the coalition’s ultimatum to capitulate or face the consequences the Premier enthusiastically and unapologetically stated to Dogville’s complicit business elite:

But here’s thing about that – here’s a little *factoid* for ya. They expect over the next fifteen years China’s economy will not just be the largest economy in the world – it will surpass the United States...

**‘CBS Evening News’ Chief Foreign Correspondent Lara Logan: Risking Her Life to Deconstruct the Last Democratic Fiefdom: Revisited Once Again; Or High Profiling Dogville Police Corruption and Twenty Years of Torturous Isolation**

[November 12, ‘06]

It’s one thing to be in a war zone for a few days, weeks or months. But to make it one’s permanent home as part of a job description cannot but substantially increase the odds injury or death will occur. It baffles the Canadian lawyer that Lara, a gorgeous, talented and remarkably charismatic soul would take up residence in one of the most dangerous cities in the world.

Yet, there she was again on the Sunday, November 12, 2006, broadcast of the ‘CBS Evening News’; and not just reporting but multi-tasking for the coalition.

It was another lifting experience to see Lara on behalf of the American news media, the U.S. military and coalition partners combine resources to cognitively emancipate the Canadian lawyer from 20 years of relentless human experimentation and daily intimidation, harassment and physical torture.

The subject-matter of her latest news report had built-in parallels with living in Dogville – corrupt police. In the Baghdad area she reported about, residents were so afraid of the police they’ve barricaded themselves in their compound using vehicles to block entranceways and shored up other access points. Later she reported what the Pentagon told CBS about the number of military deaths in Iraq that day. She reported there had been **five**...

**'CBS Evening News': Acknowledging the "Wait for Justice" and a Kidmanesque Resolution in the Last Democratic Fiefdom**

On Saturday, November 4, 2006, the 'CBS Evening News' again mobilized its resources to send messages to the East-West Corridor of Diplomacy. This time the caption "Wait for Justice" – rendered in red and yellow – was employed to signal an affirmation that the Canadian lawyer is in the process of achieving it from one of the two culpable and liable parties: China.

The punishment issue was also high profiled. Allan Pizzey's segment on pampered dogs in Japan was replete with coalition language to indicate that the Kidmanesque regime of punishment was going to be implemented if all of the international community's demands were not met.

**'CBS Evening News': Dedicating the Last Segment of the Week to Advance the Interests and Objectives of the Coalition**

[October 27, '06]

For quite a while CBS News has reserved the last slot on Friday's broadcast for members of its viewing public – giving them an opportunity to vote on-line for one of three stories profiled the previous week the previous Friday by correspondent Steve Hartman. The one that gets the most votes during the week is the one that's broadcast.

The color pink has been employed by coalition members since early April 2006 almost every day as a symbol of 'condemnation' for all the heinous criminality, tortious conduct and human rights violations Canada's fiefdom elite and Beijing's

military agents committed against the Canadian lawyer and all the other serious malfeasance they did to his country. It will be recalled that pink was the first color to be military mobilized. The color was introduced into the lexicon on April 3, 2006: *Just How Fast the Coalition Community Reacts to Events and Circumstances in the Last Democratic Fiefdom.*

During the last full week of October there were many coalition initiatives. One of them was Secretary of Defense Donald Rumsfeld reminding the malfeasant the day before what happened to France's entire ruling elite in 1794: *Secretary of Defense Donald Rumsfeld: History is About to Repeat Itself in the Last Democratic Fiefdom.* In one historical account from 15, 000 to 40,000 were executed with another 100,000 detained or imprisoned.

This continued threat linkage of Canada with the war on terror\* accomplishes many things: the suspension of partisan politics in the US on how to resolve the Chinada problem in Canada – the consolidation of political support behind the President, mobilization of military resources, the perception that demonization of Canada is justified and unanimity that there be the severest punishment for those who refused to stand down the aggression.

During the 'CBS Evening News', Mark Phillips filed the last report of the broadcast on a scandal that's erupted in what is traditionally a scandal-free gentleman's activity: Cricket.

Everyday coalition partners rely on the Canadian lawyer's highly evolved perception skills to identify messages meant for 'east' portion of the East-West Corridor. During the August 22<sup>nd</sup> broadcast of CBS' evening news, the final segment of the program contained a message to add one more item to the list of what the China-Canada military alliance is being put on 'notice' of.

'Cheating' is a one-word description of several elements of the internationally condemned paradigm of governance that's been operating in Canada trans-generationally. In 129 years of international competition, one team, Pakistan, has forfeited a game to another – England – because the umpire accused the Pakistanis of cheating [clip timed to reveal red and white combination – red insignia on umpire's white shirt; followed by close-up of red cricket ball with umpires' white shirt, black ties background] [...] And the incident has become a scandal in the cricketing world [white sign, red lettering] from Islamabad ["We want justice"] to New York [clip of yellow cab with red tail lights].

Bob wraps the segment and the evening broadcast with "We cast a very wide net in our effort to continuously find news for you".

---

## **'CBS Evening News': A Marvelous Way to Capture the Post-Emancipation Life of Wealth**

[August 15, '06]

On the Tuesday, August 15, 2006, edition of the 'CBS Evening News', producers delivered a powerful signal to the Dogville apartment of torture, enslavement, impoverishment, imprisonment and experimentation about how they viewed the Canadian lawyer's future.

It was embedded in Bob's intro to the last segment of the broadcast. The news item was a special interest story about a Spanish television show that had been on the air longer than other in history – some 44 years. It wasn't the numerology, ideology and propaganda deconstruction dynamic that combining these two numbers created that got the Canadian's attention, for it was impossible in the circumstances to massage that statistic.

What was superlative was the intro script and it being linked to a carefully selected clip comprised of three women standing side-by-side on set all dressed in bold Canadian colors. The Canada condemnation and coalition-identification intention was clever in design. But it was what Bob said coupled with this image that really hit the out of the park home run.

[This is] what Ed Sullivan may have called a 'really big show'.

## **How the 'CBS Evening News' Got Aggressive Against the Last Democratic Fiefdom**

[July 31, '06]

Every hour of the last day of July 2006 was filled with non-stop coalition activity. Maintaining ubiquitous encirclement, inflicting constant embarrassment and using the East-West Corridor to keep putting the China-Canada military alliance on notice were the objectives of every single coalition partner.

On the July 31st broadcast, a lavender attired Bob introduced the report from Sharyn who was reporting from Israel. She wore a green Tee shirt.

Bob Orr and his team got creative when they edited his voiceover remark, "unmatched misery" to a pink attired heat sufferer. The Canadian lawyer found this encouraging both as it captured the essence of his twenty years and communicated how the malfeasants are going to feel after the coalition gets really aggressive. There would be nothing that would make him happier than to see them suffer in massive pain. For example, he would be elated if many of them weren't killed outright, but had their spinal cords severed, causing them to live the rest of their

lives in a wheel chair either as paraplegics or quadriplegics. That would be sweet retribution.

Certainly, living the fast and high life like Saddam and his extended family did, then finding oneself either in prison or eeking out a living dumpster diving or the equivalent would be such a contrast in lifestyles, the pain and suffering it would cause would be existentially punishing.

Trish did the same clever editing during her report. She timed the phrase "we should be worried" to a clip of a woman holding a red and white toy. Again, the coalition was expressing its deep concern that the conflicts of today ought not be something that's inherited by the children of today and the unborn. And it also reinforces the view that living under totalitarian rule is so inimical to what parents and leaders want for their children, that they'd do everything in their power to prevent that outcome.

Jerry Bowen's segment on new technology included him wearing a green tie and doing his correspondent's monologue on a violet backdrop. The geo-signals of immense *quantum* and justice for the malfeasant were exceptionally pronounced – and being the last report of the broadcast, the message was even more poignant.

---

### **A Couple Weeks in the Life of the 'CBS Evening News': Quarantine and Peripheralize the Leaders and Supporters of the Last Democratic Fiefdom**

[April '06]

Coalition initiatives in the coercive diplomacy department were unrelenting during the end of April and through the first couple weeks of May 2006. The following are what the coalition's members contributed to deconstruct the last democratic fiefdom.

By the end of April 2006 the coalition's members were firing on all cylinders in their sentiments of hostility to compel the Chinada elite to capitulate, compensate and change.

Just before the beginning of the 'CBS Evening News' on Saturday, April 29, all the anchors on KIRO 7 News in Seattle morbidly wore all black attire to deliver the message just how committed the coalition is to effect change in Canada and force the Beijing government to stand down and withdraw from the country.

When the CBS news broadcast the first segment, anchor Mika Brzezinski communicated a numerology, ideology and propaganda deconstruction initiative with respect to the number of American troops who had died in the Iraqi Corridor of Diplomacy. The figure '2,402' translated into a  $2 + 4 + 2 = \mathbf{eight}$ .

In Allan Pizzey's segment on Iraq's military leaders, there was a quasi-Clooney M. executed by one of the commanders attending a conference.

Mika also introduced a terrorism story and the caption graphic that accompanied the segment was in Canadian colors. A *quantum* ratification dynamic was scripted in when she reported there were a seemingly non-coincidental '11,111' terrorist attacks to date: a total of **five** number ones.

Joie Chen reported on a New Orleans college story. She got a college student she filmed to execute a quasi-Clooney M.. A Kidmanesque reference was scripted with the phrase "trying to sniff out the mold". And there was a quick clip of students walking for the camera. One wore a white shirt and red collar and two others were side by side – one in red and one in white – thus creating the Canadian color embarrassment and deconstruction dynamic.

Mika got really coercive when she filed a report in the segment entitled "Weekend Journal". She profiled a talented and giving musician named Mark Wood who, advised of the Canada-China problem, added the following comments: "I'm changing the whole ground rules" and "I don't just go in there, squeak a couple little tunes and leave. We blow their heads off"; and executed a quasi-Clooney M. to corroborate he had been asked to convey a coercive message to the audience in the East-West corridor of diplomacy.

On the Sunday, April 30th broadcast, Russ Mitchell who anchored the half hour program wore Canadian colors.

To tag-team the visual perceptions of those in the East-West corridor of diplomacy, the first correspondent's news item was Joie Chen who also wore Canadian colors – a red shirt and a white undershirt; and to jam the Chinada elite and Chinese military executed a Clooney M.. She reported that there were 180,000 reported dead in Darfur – a number that could have been slightly massaged to deliver a numerology, ideology and propaganda deconstruction initiative.

Elizabeth Palmer reported from Tehran and the Iranian government's continue defiance of the international community and the U.S. demand the country's nuclear program be decommissioned. To deliver a message of condemnation and accountability from half way round the world, Elizabeth wore an unmistakably pink head scarf – the head attire needed to comply with local custom.

Allen Pizzey reported from Iraq and added the second numerology, ideology and propaganda deconstruction initiative of the evening, reporting there were **eight** bodies found; with some showing signs of torture. Russell asked during a live feed. "is this [latest problem] just a speed bump or is this new government really in trouble?". Allen responded, "It's certainly a speed bum, Russ, but it also could be big trouble"; which was the same kind of dynamic that was going on in Canada as it declined to address the coalition's issues.

And that's how the news that evening on CBS concluded.

There is no doubt in anybody's mind involved with the coalition that accountability and justice will be served upon those who thumb their nose at democracy and free

market capitalism. The evidence of malfeasance is so overwhelming; as is the arrogant tenaciousness of seeking a new global order with China's and Canada's ideology of idiocy, stupidity and sociopathic criminality ruling. Soon enough they will be peripheralized from society. It cannot but be this way; for if they are allowed to expand their influence, the foundations of modern western civilization will be swept away and another dark ages will descend on humanity. It should be recalled what was argued in *Institutionalized Contemptuous Envy, Cognitive Civil War, the Advancement of Excellence and their Relevance to the Demise of the Last Democratic Fiefdom*:

This is nothing short of a civil war going on between the smart and the professed to be smart. There are two diametrically opposed identifiable categories of people both seeking a legitimacy at the expense of the other.

There is thus an exigent set of circumstances that requires tenacious attention; it is the objective of preserving modern democracy and free market capitalism. China's leaders still have at least another fifty years or more before their cognitive capacity and maturity catches up with the West. They're still medieval thinking; and the Canadian elite wants to be medieval thinking. Neither can be allowed to expand their influence. And the first step to achieving the objective is totally crushing the last democratic fiefdom.

**CBS Evening News Continuing Support for the Coalition Assembled to Decimate the Last Democratic Fiefdom**

It doesn't take much to yell from the highest geo-political mountaintop these days. Simply broadcasting one, a couple or a few segments on the evening news with coalition discourse is enough to corroborate years of diplomacy and mounds of condemnation. In the place of enormous effort, time and expense planning, writing, producing, editing and proofing segments with geo-content, there were those gems of accountability woven in for all in the East-West Corridor of Coercive Diplomacy to witness.

CBS News re-broadcast Secretary Rumsfeld's Al Arabiya interview and Trish Regan wore the new color of condemnation – pink – in place of the 'green' before and the day after the bright red on a white building backdrop. Is 'green' in coalition contexts to now represent the Canadian lawyer's vast wealth?

## **'CBS Evening News' Ramming Accountability Down the Throats of the Last Democratic Fiefdom**

[April 10, '06]

The Canadian lawyer will never forget the day the NBC Nightly News incorporated Canadian colors into every single one of **eight** news segments to grind the Canadian elite and Chinese for their vile paradigm of governance (*Dedicating an Entire NBC News Broadcast to Condemning the Last Democratic Fiefdom*). Viacom's 'CBS Evening News' came close to that remarkable achievement on Monday, April 10, 2006, when almost every segment contained Canadian colors. Suffice it to say, the broadcast was a clear testament to the commitment and dedication of the coalition to finish what it with Viacom's help started.

Viacom's 'CBS Evening News', the Canadian lawyer's chosen favorite dinner time news broadcast for years accomplished what its market competitor and coalition partner achieved a few weeks ago: producing and writing Canadian colors into virtually every segment broadcast that evening. While beyond the perceptual realm of the general public, how the producers choreographed each segment to include red and white combinations was remarkably ingenious.

With the headlines at the end of the first week of April and during the weekend all about the Mexican immigration issue and the country-wide marching protests, it took some real creativity and time to generate the color schemes pronounced enough to be unmistakable to the audience in the East-West Corridor of 'Coercive Diplomacy'.

In the first segment, Chief Whitehouse Correspondent Jim Axelrod interviewed an illegal immigrant who's one daughter executed an obviously pre-planned Clooney M.; which was followed by a clip of two of his children dressed in Canadian colors as they marched. Another clip during the segment could only have been coalition generated by pulling out of the crowd a person wearing red and white attire. These two incidents were bolstered by editing in a short clip of President Bush speaking that day at John's Hopkins University who was wearing the same color combination.

The next segment on the same topic of immigration, reported by Byron Pitts, involved more of the same. The Canadian lawyer couldn't help but notice the choreographed scene where Byron is interviewing a marcher surrounded by two others and the color combination of attire was white-red-white – the Canadian flag.

Trish Regan then reported on the Durham rape. How could he not immediately notice she was wearing an exceptionally bright red turtleneck shirt and standing in front of nothing but a white backdrop of buildings? The stark contrast between her attire and the background was remarkable.

It cannot be underestimated how profound this contribution to the coalition cause is to deconstructing the Canadian and Chinese hegemonic's grip on power and wealth. As has been documented in previous and what will be demonstrated in *Fiefdom* chapters is just how much this daily pressure is having an effect. The elite of

Canada are feeling it, don't like it and haven't the abilities or talents to repel or insulate themselves from it. The encirclement, embarrassment and condemnation dynamics have become ubiquitous. From the new leadership to the lowly street soldier commander, they're all frustrated, anxious, annoyed and choked. Nothing like this has ever happened to them and they haven't the cognitive tools to challenge its power and authority. They can't slander it without looking stupid. They can't stop it and so look powerless. And they can't appease it without abandoning the only way of life they and children know: a life of barbaric domination and cruel subjugation in the last democratic fiefdom.

### **How the 'CBS Evening News' Struck Out the Last Democratic Fiefdom**

[March 29, '06]

The Wednesday, March 29, 2006, edition of the 'CBS Evening News' contained three news items produced to catch both the Canadian lawyer's coalition eye and further demoralize Canada's entrepreneurially uninventive and monopolistically sociopathic elite.

On the Wednesday following the anniversary week of the President's human experimentation foreign policy statement the Canadian lawyer observed again how intimately aware coalition members are of his post-emancipation plans. He watched the program start with the headliner news item filed by Chief Foreign Correspondent Lara Logan who is stationed in Iraq and then observed how the next three items not only had Canadian colors prominently displayed, but each identified a major corporate or philanthropic initiative documented repeatedly in the *Fiefdom* treatise.

The second news item involved a topic at the core of the treatise and central to the coalition's objective of reform in Canada: political corruption. Gloria Berger, wearing a full red outfit with a string of white pearls, reported on the Abramoff lobbying scandal in which one of the most powerful men on 'K Street' was not only sentenced to jail for five years and ten months but was ordered by the judge to pay more than \$21 million in restitution.

Producers of CBS News also ran a news item on eco-energy – a central pillar of the Canadian lawyer's corporate plans. The "E." in the name of 'International E.R. Memorial Centre' stands for eco-energy. Further, the eco-military tourism infrastructure is going to be designed primarily employing green technologies.

CBS correspondent Trish Regan was sent to Brazil to report on how the country successfully researched a sugarcane based gasoline. What turned it into a coalition-inspired story was the fact the Sugar Cane Agro-industry Union President interviewed was wearing a red tie and white shirt.

The Canadian lawyer's dedication to the 'war effort' has been key since the international community ratified his US\$5 billion compensation. Waiting for

emancipation, he carefully mapped out a strategy to put a large portion of these funds towards what was the most important to him, what should be a priority for every western country and what was paramount to the international community at war with an unrelenting, barbaric enemy.

This kind of vision and commitment is seriously lacking in Canada's elite. They remain hidden from view; spending the money they plundered over generations and not only devising more ways to make more to the exclusion of the country's citizenry, but are working closely with the Chinese to maintain their shared hegemony. Instead of being visionary, entrepreneurial and risk takers, they are isolationistic, hedonistic, sociopathic and demented. If the dynamic between coalition members and the Canadian elite and Chinese was analogous to a baseball game, the CBS News broadcast would have just struck out the last democratic fiefdom.
