'NBC Nightly News': The Coalition Calls Canada's Elections "Fraudulent"

[June 29, '08]

There was no denying or equivocating what the coalition stated using the lexicon on the diplomatic record during the June 29, 2008 broadcast of the 'NBC Nightly News'. In Ned Colt's segment on the 'coronation' of the Zimbabwe dictator, the following was observed:

Today some of the handful of elections observers allowed in [clip: observer Federer M.] called the election fraudulent.

The intent was to denounce elections in Canada as shams(1) because of the factionless nature of the country's federal, provincial and municipal system of governance(2). The lack of political pluralism combined with a secret street soldier army numbering between three to five million(3) that votes *en masse* for the Liberals steals the country's elections from thirty million who have been misled into believing their votes count for something, when they don't at all.

'NBC Nightly News': The Canadian lawyer is a "Senior Member of an American Political Dynasty"

[May 18, '08]

At virtually exactly the same time as CBS was calling the Canadian lawyer an "American political icon", NBC was also maintaining his international persona. At the top of its newscast, Lester's script "a senior member of an American political dynasty" was timed to a clip of Senator Kennedy (attired in prison certainty) executing a Colbert M..

'NBC Nightly News': Confirming Surveillance Footage of Malfeasance, There's a New Political Reality in Canada and the Canadian lawyer's Hero Status

[December 30, '07]

On the eve of New Year's Eve, NBC broadcast several communiqués for the audience in the East-West Corridor of Diplomacy.

Lester, in prison certainty and presidential *quantum*, began the newscast with a Thalia M. timed to "no matter where you go, there are multiple video cameras rolling" – intended to remind Canada's malfeasant that wherever they were and are the Pentagon and CIA have been and are recording them. It is always advantageous to remind those who fear nothing of the accumulation of evidence that proof of their criminality, tortious and human rights violating conduct and United Nations infringing warmongering is being collected; and now in an assumed geo-political context of the inevitability of international justice.

During a segment on the assassinated Pakistani's son taking her place, a clip of him executing a Colbert M. was timed to the remark "a new political reality" – a way for producers to describe the emerging paradigm of democratic governance in Canada. Her son said she always said "democracy is the best revenge"; naturally an adage that struck a chord with the Canadian lawyer and coalition partners .

It was rare for Lester to execute a Clooney M., so what it was timed to was important to NBC executives and producers. It was timed to the word "hero"; and was immediately followed by a female NBC assistant sitting right behind the anchor chair executing **three** Clooney M.s, timed to "not recognized 'till now"; which corroborated and strengthened NBC's first communiqué about what they thought of the Canadian lawyer.

'NBC Nightly News': Expect Prison and Fatalities and the Coalition is the Largest and Most Technologically Advanced and Has Staying Power

[December 31, '07]

NBC's New Year's Eve broadcast had several communiqués for East-West Corridor of Diplomacy consumption.

Lester (prison certainty – justice) anchored and introduced a segment, timing "[take] a hard look at" to a clip of the close-up of a chain link fence – a clever way of presenting the certainty of prison for the so-called invincible, insulated and immune.

Lee scripted his segment on the presidential race to include a clip of a resident he interviewed executing two Erin M.s timed to his chat with a campaigner stating "[this is] the largest and most technologically advanced campaign" – diplomatically referring to the coalition's resources and personnel.

Rhema also scripted her segment for geo-political purposes. She interviewed an expert attired in prison certainty (Canada) and arranged for a student to sit behind them attired in prison certainty (punishment certainty); and while the audience saw this wardrobe choreography included the remark "online education is not going away" – NBC's way of describing the resilience of the coalition to achieve its objectives. If Canada's three sub-factions think they can hunker down and ride out this historical accountability and reform storm, they're sorely mistaken.

Finally, being the last show of the year, producers aired an 'In Memoriam' segment – acknowledging the passing of high profile and celebrities in 2007. Throughout was the presence of a Redstone-Moonves M. – a profound statement of intent in the coercive diplomacy category of persuasion.

'NBC Nightly News': Confirms the East-West Corridor of Diplomacy is a Center of the Geo-Political Universe

[December 13, '07]

While the Canadian lawyer continues to feel the drag of time waiting for emancipation and taking possession of his coalition arranged wealth, there are always many bright spots during each and every day. Those experiences consist of coalition partners again tapping that seemingly inexhaustible well of uber-creativity – surprising him with what makes American culture, whether it be for example film, music or news, a superior thinking and innovating nation.

His intellectual and emotional uplifts are as much a result of being made to feel daily, often hourly, he's pivotal and pinnacle within the ever-growing global community of democracy, human rights, pluralism and free market capitalism advocates as it is witnessing this non-stop flow of new Coalition content.

That uber-creativity was in full view on December 13, 2007 during the NBC newscast. It began with what only the trained East-West Corridor eye would see as a reflection back into the diplomatic office an observation made earlier that day and documented in the *Fiefdom treatise: what was articulated in Outer Space, Washington, New York and London: More Proof the East-West Corridor of Diplomacy is a Center of the Geo-Political Universe*.

Producers aired a video caption of a snowstorm as an introduction to a segment on a weather topic. They instructed one of their camera personnel or found in the archives a clip of a highway sign: "Junction **20**".

Finally, producers timed Brian's scripted remark "He was forced to resign" with a camera direction to Andrea who was attired in prison certainty (punishment

certainty) – the coalition’s way of stating to Canada’s malfeasant ‘surrender your office or be forcefully purged’..

‘NBC Nightly News’: Drawing Direct Attention to the Diplomatic Lexicon

[December 7, ‘07]

To end the first week of December 2007, NBC producers decided to have some fun at the expense of those to whom the communiqué was directed. It was the sixty-sixth anniversary of the day that will live in infamy – Pearl Harbour Day – the kind of experience the United States is trying to prevent happening *albeit* through subtler means; namely being blind-sided by a hitherto publicly undeclared enemy - Chinada.

Brian wore an extra bright prison certainty (punishment certainty) tie for the December 7, 2007 newscast; and read a supposedly authentic email from a supposed viewer:

Finally, Jane writes from Washington:

My family loves your evening news broadcast. You may think this is crazy, but your tie takes up so much of the screen that it broadcasts a message... I am so happy that you have stopped wearing striped ties.

Jane, sorry about that. We hope you'll still watch. We're happy you're all watching so closely. [Cl.M.] Thanks to all of you as always for writing. We read them all. It's important to hear from you.

‘NBC Nightly News’: Canada’s Malfeasant are “Incurable”

[December 4, ‘07]

During a segment on the December 4, 2007 NBC newscast about one of the presidential candidates’ wives a clip was specifically chosen – of the candidate executing a Diaz-Clooney M. combination – and timed to the word “incurable”; which was an accurate prognosis of the psychological dysfunctionality of Canada’s three sub-factions.

The evidence that’s accumulated not only over twenty years – what was observed and experienced in the late 1980s and early 1990s – but more importantly after the coalition began its aggressive and protracted diplomacy clearly leads to the belief that Canada’s leaders in the public and private sectors are incapable of self-reform; and that it will have to be imposed through the ‘purge & punish’ process.

'NBC Nightly News': Tag-Teaming with CBS News on the Issue of the Coalition's Objective of Cutting Down Lawlessness in Canada

[November 30, '07]

After CBS news underscored the coalition desire to reduce state-sponsored – or institutionalized – crime in Canada, as documented in the previous chapter, NBC news said exactly the same thing. During John Yang's segment on the presidential race he geo-politically stated:

[Rudy Giuliani] recently boasted that New York City [clip: police officer: Cl.M.] was the only U.S. city to cut crime every year since 1994 – the year he became Mayor.

'NBC Nightly News': Heavily Employing the Numbers in the Diplomatic Lexicon

[November 7, '07]

On November 7, 2006, NBC producers really pummelled Canada's malfeasant with the diplomatic lexicon during the segment involving Anne, who was reporting from the South Pole. This was just like the week before when the lexicon made it to outer space on October 28, 2007. Now it was being employed at one of the two tips of the world for the first time.

Brian confirmed it was minus **53** degrees. Anne stated she had to wait **eight** days before the weather cleared sufficiently to take the trip to the pole; that during that time **twenty** flights had been cancelled; and the storms were so bad there was only **twenty** feet of visibility and **55** miles per hour winds.

'NBC Nightly News': The Diplomatic Lexicon Makes It to Outer Space

[October 28, '07]

A first for the coalition's new diplomatic language – and one that's out of this word *literally* – was observed on October 28, 2007. During Tom Costello's segment on the new addition to the International Space Station, one of the astronauts executed an Aussie M. when the Commander stated "we're always having too much fun".

'NBC Nightly News': A Rooney Maneuver, Confirming the "Terrible Personal Hardship" Facing Canada's Malfeasant

[October 22, '07]

The October 22, 2007 broadcast included Brian executing a Rooney M. – another swift acknowledgment of a new addition to the diplomatic lexicon; and doing so

timed to the remark “[X] facing a terrible personal hardship”. It wasn’t hard to figure out what that communiqué was all about.

‘NBC Nightly News’: Underscores How the Coalition Has been Working Long and Hard to Make Prison Happen for the So-Called Invincible, Insulated and Immune

[October 6, ‘07]

It may have been a simple editing-in of a clip on October 6, 2007, but the ramifications for the lives of hundreds of thousands of Canadians leading or linked to the country’s security apparatus and the China-Canada alliance were profound.

During a segment on a North Korea delegation of martial artists in the U.S. for an exhibition, a clip of one of the visitors in prison certainty was timed to the remark “[the organizer] spent fifteen years making it happen.

‘NBC Nightly News’: High Profiling the On-Going Hypno-Torture of the Canadian Lawyer and Senior Senators Confirm *Quantum* and Prison Certainty

[October 4, ‘07]

On October 4, 2007 the national network was also still livid over the hypno-battery against the Canadian lawyer and high profiled his experiences being a victim of institutionalized and militarized torture.

Andrea:[protracted B.I.M.] There’s also an impact on foreign policy. Secretary of State Condoleezza Rice has promised U.S. allies that the administration does not use torture even though officials say she knew about the memo.

A most senior member of the U.S. Senate, Patrick Leahy (Dem. Vt.), used Andrea’s segment to send both a prison certainty and presidential *quantum* communiqué. The Democratic senator was central in assessing matters related to the Arar affair – the Canadian who spent a year being tortured in a Syrian jail and then got \$10.5 million in damages:

Senator Kenney was also observed in the segment – giving a speech and delivering a prison certainty communiqué.

‘CBS Evening News’ and the ‘NBC Nightly News’: “The White House to the Rescue” Leaving Chinada “Very Worried”

[August 31, ‘07]

Historians will look back and marvel at how much pressure CBS and NBC put on Canada's leadership and Beijing's assets in the country. Day after week after month for over a year and a half the two networks pounded them with a barrage of non-stop demands to capitulate or face serious consequences. That hold no punches attitude was again observed on August 31, 2007, the last day of summer 2007.

'NBC Nightly News': High Profiling Chinada's Article 7 Stealth Cognition Technology R&D and the Canadian Lawyer Being a Lab Monkey

[July 28, '07]

There was no mistaking the geo-political import of the last segment of the NBC newscast on July 28, 2007. Producers set the stage by attiring Lester in two forms of prison certainty – one of which was presidential *quantum*, which was another reminder to the Canadian lawyer and those who are going to compensate him for their two decades of criminality that cost him a normal life.

The segment that high profiled the illegal R&D that turned him into a lab monkey for the China-Canada alliance was about the Rwandan gorilla population. ITV's Neal Connery's script included the following remarks:

It's truly *mesmerizing* to get this close to one of the world's most endangered species.

'NBC Nightly News': Treating the Malfeasant Like the Terrorists They Are and Reminding the Canadian Lawyer of Marital Bliss Coming

[June 22, '07]

There were two primary themes during the June 22, 2007 NBC newscast. One was to demonize Canada's malfeasant and the other was to again remind the Canadian lawyer his every wish from a family creation angle is going to be satisfied.

Three Kidmanesque captions:

- (i) "Terror Alert": Chinada colors;
- (ii) "Deadly Attack": Chinada colors;
- (iii) "Wounds of War": Canadian punishment certainty; and
- (iv) "The War in Iraq": Canadian flag color sequence.

To remind the incorrigibly arrogant and belligerent of the futility of fighting the U.S. military, a female amputee vet was profiled. In punishment certainty attire, she

executed a Blair M. to “realization of death is there” – another Dogville-style reference.

In another segment a wedding dress segment contained Canadian punishment certainty colors. The well-known high fashion designer created a line for the Target department store. He dressed for his interview in red bandana and black shirt and stood in front of several white dresses to create the lexicon’s color scheme.

‘NBC Nightly News’: Acknowledging the ‘New Canada’ is Protecting U.S. National Security Interests

[May 17, ‘07]

Right after CBS news producers got through with what appeared to be another warning to capitulate, NBC news sent more messages of that caliber. Lisa filed a report on body armor used by the military and executed an in-your-face Blair M. to “independent ballistic tests” – intended to be diplomatically coercive.

Tom’s segment on gas prices began with the caption “Pumped Up”, rendered in Canada’s official colors; and he executed a Maria M. – high profiling the United States energy dependence issue involving Alberta oil.

‘NBC Nightly News’: High Profiling Canada Geese and Drawing a Parallel Between Them Being a Messy Pest and the Last Democratic Fiefdom

[May 2, ‘07]

On May 2, 2007, NBC news finished the broadcast with a segment that must have drawn howls of laughter when conceived in executive offices, non-stop giggles in the editing room and controlled elation in the studio.

Canada’s internationally recognized bird was front and center on America’s national stage and not perceived in a flattering light. In fact the opposite – as a noisy, pesky and messy undesirable.

Brian introduced the segment with a caption that read “Frequent Fliers”. The report was entitled “Not in My Backyard” – which in a geo-political context referred to institutional corruption, perversion and idiocy and a authoritarianthreat:

Brian: We have a dinner hour warning for you [Bl.M.] While the subject of this next story isn’t so bad, Canada geese after all can be beautiful [Bl.M.] when you see them in flight. It’s what they do on the ground that is the subject of this next report. Here’s NBC’s Bob Faw.

Bob: Soaring, they are majestic. But aground they are ravenous. That's the problem.

Expert: The problem is what they leave behind and that's hard to deal with.

Bob: One goose can eat **five** pounds of grass a day and leave behind four pounds a day behind.

Bird Co. CEO: They will drop a load, if I can say that, about every seven or **eight** minutes.

Bob: Fiercely protective – and they mate for life – they even made news recently* in Cincinnati, charging passers by at a mall who got too close to their nest.

With urban sprawl, ponds and open space – what they need – are shrinking; but their numbers are exploding: over **twenty** million by some estimates.

Expert: They seem to have doubled or **tripled** in numbers.

Bob: Yes, you could round them up and truck them, say, **five**, hours away. They actually tried that here; only it didn't work. The geese came back. You could addle the eggs to make sure they don't hatch. Recently they did that in Chicago; or resort to high intensity lights like dozens of communities are doing.

Bird Co. CEO: After **three** or four nights or not sleeping – well, they decide maybe this isn't the pond for them. They like to move on.

Bob: But the best remedy might just be four-legged.

Dog Handler: [clip of dog chasing birds] Okay Peg, [whistles] that'll do.

Bob: Border Collies like Peg – they don't round up geese; they scatter them.

Bird Co. CEO: You wear them down and you get them to understand that this property is not theirs.

Bob: Of course, it takes a lot to get a goose's dander down – whatever man proposes they do keep flocking back. True, your feet might not want to go where the wild goose goes. But your heart still goes. Bob Faw, NBC News, Oyster Bay, New York.

Brian: Bon appetite. That's our broadcast for your Tuesday night.

'NBC Nightly News': "Stop" or You'll Have a Real War on Your Hands

[January 18, '07]

Two nights in a row NBC producers scripted two segments that, combined, signals that if Canada's three sub-factions and the Beijing leadership don't halt what the international community has condemned them for, President Bush will have no alternative but to use the pre-emptive military option.

The first during the January 17th and 18th broadcasts was a slightly reformulated caption. The phrase "War in Iraq" had been employed for months; many times rendered in official Canadian and Chinese colors. This time to make it more apparent that coalition partners were referring to Canada, the line between "War in" and "Iraq" was changed. Instead of a solid red line, it was rendered in red-white-red – to more resembled the color scheme of the Canadian flag.

Then on the 18th, embedded in the ice storm segment, the film crew was instructed to take a close-up shot of a stop sign. The red and white of the sign – Canadian colors – and the word "STOP" were a final demand to stand down Chinese hegemony in the country, stop coddling the Beijing leadership, stop refusing to verifiably account for Pandora's Box assets and instituting democratic reform, stop corrupting government and stop terrorizing innocent people.

'NBC Nightly News': "War [and] Politics"

[October 28, '06]

The amount of coalition activity during the October 28th broadcast of the NBC news was considerable. The first was the caption graphic that became the title to this chapter. "War Politics" was rendered in Canadian colors – "war" in white and "politics" in red. It was an affirmation of the official state of hostilities between the parties to the coalition and the parties to the China-Canada alliance.

The next segment not only had a caption graphic that was coalition relevant, but the story was too. Correspondent Lisa Myers' inserting corruption gestures were the red flags indicating coalition relevance.

The segment profiled a prominent political party election helper who engaged in dirty tricks during an election and for which he was convicted as a felon and spent three months in prison. When the caption graphic "Dirty Tricks" was rendered in black letters and surrounded by a white aura – punishment certainty – and Lisa's voiceover "a prominent [helper] with a reputation for bare knuckle tactics" was timed to the man executing what was turned into an aggressive Clooney M., it was

evident the geo-political purpose of the segment was to highlight the democracy-evaporating strategies and tactics employed by Canada's federal, provincial and municipal politicians and the Beijing government in the country's multi-jurisdictional election process.

Coalition partners have accepted the *Fiefdom* treatise allegation of massive election rigging on all three levels of Canadian politics; and not just by the previously dominant federal party, the Liberal Party of Canada, but in conspiratorious union with the Conservative Party of Canada, the New Democratic Party of Canada and Beijing. It will be recalled in *Why Both the Liberal and Conservative Political Parties are Culpable and Liable for Atrocities Committed in by and for the Last Democratic Fiefdom* proof was submitted into the diplomatic evidence record that there was no distinction in practice between the political parties – that their independence from each other was a sophisticated façade because all their prominent members have been and continue to be nepotistically maneuvered into those positions. It has also been argued that the January 2006 federal election results proved that the fiefdom-totalitarian alliance's multi-million street soldier army was secretly mobilized in a failed attempt to rig the election in the Liberal's favor and would have succeeded had millions of normal Canadians not retaliated for the media-uncontainable corruption scandals of the Chrétien government. The following was argued in *President Bush: A Top Priority is Protecting Human Rights, Fighting Corruption and Challenging the Erosion of Democracy in the Last Democratic Fiefdom*:

Foreign governments meddling in the dynamics of elections is a massively troubling dynamic and will not be tolerated by the United States government. The intent behind foreign governments utilizing resources to effectively alter the course of an election is to deprive the people of their right to be represented by whom they want to be governed by – a fundamental tenet of modern democracy. Undermining election results both in theory and practice means that the will of the foreign power is being prioritized and the new governors are but an extension of that country's foreign policy agenda. Therefore, for a totalitarian government to help install its choice for leader, there's more than a perception its policies will be given priority over the national and regional interests of indigenous factions.

It was evident from the results and statistics in Canada's January 2006 election that the Chinese influence was very pronounced. Having been invited to introduce military and intelligence assets into the country beginning thirty-five years ago, Beijing worked covertly and diligently with the elite to perpetuate what it achieved over the first three-quarters of the last century, namely to fortify Canada's power centers with elite-loyal voters. In other words, it used resources over generations and strategized with a foreign power to rig elections in its favor. When political authority falls to the political party on the other side of the isle, power isn't lost since politics in the country is factionless. There's just an inter-family shrug of the shoulders and a "Well, next time" attitude.

The election results proved that the elite-Chinese community mobilized its human resources in the major power and economic centers in the country: Toronto, Montreal and Vancouver. It was the "everywhere else" vote that won the minority government for the Conservatives and only because the Liberal record on corruption weighed heavily in the entire country minus those three rigged cities.

It was evident very quickly just how much influence Beijing's desires were acted upon after the election. The first major decision by the new Prime Minister was to permit Dogville central's Liberal MP David Emerson to cross the floor and take a Cabinet seat.

To make sure the linkage between the NBC news story and democracy-adverse Canadian election dynamics was corroborated, Lisa executed a quasi-Clooney M. during the last few frames of the segment.

Note: *Fiefdom* treatise recipients recall *The Coalition Deems Canada's Federal, Provincial and Municipal Elections "Fraudulent"*

The question would be reasonably asked how does do the trans-generationally wealthy and Chinese finance this election rigging? It would take a substantial annual sum to maintain the number of soldiers and their party loyalty.

How does a federal government and provincial and municipal governments sustain a large secret army without the public becoming aware of it? Easy; there are two sets of books. The first are what the government keeps and are both transparent and audited by the Auditor General of Canada. The tax receipt and expenditure accounts and records are scrutinized using generally accepted accounting principles. The other set of books are the ones secretly kept that record the money paid by the invisibly wealthy into a secret army operation and maintenance fund that is not transparent. It's technically private. It is beyond the reach of the Auditor General. The wealthy have decided that it's in their best interests to fund the secret society of street soldiers because it perpetuates their trans-generational paradigm of governance that generates more money than it costs to fund it.

Economy monopolization and wealth plundering dynamics are the source of these funds. Part of the money that's surreptitiously extracted from Canada's economic engine is used to finance the secret army. The foundation of this argument was argued in the fourth chapter of Volume Two, *The Paradigm of Governing the Last Democratic Fiefdom*:

[T]he quiet plundering of a region's resources went on generation after generation. And, one of the most profound kickers of all of this circumstance is that this vast wealth is liquidated and then serves as the economic and political foundation from which to further brutalize, subjugate and

monopolize the west's natural wealth and hijack personal and community strengths for successive generations to come.

For example, if a member of the fiefdom-totalitarian elite generates \$100 million in revenue that he or she wouldn't have except for membership in the secret society and kicks back \$10 million to support the street soldier community that guaranteed that revenue, he or she is still up \$90 million.

The other source of funds is, of course, the Beijing government. Since it now has and has had for some three and a half decades a sovereignty, military and economic stake in the country, it stands to gain handsomely as 'spoils of war' by funding to maintain, enlarge and strengthen the secret street soldier army. And the same dynamic applies. Beijing kicks in, hypothetically, \$10 billion a year that isn't recorded in any government book-keeping. To protect the financial arrangement and expenditure system, it is treated as a 'national security' interest – the same 'national security' that prevented the Canadian lawyer from getting document disclosure in his federal litigation to prove he was a twenty-year Chinese lab monkey. Beijing's military and multi-billionaire generals pocket, say, \$50 billion in economic monopolization revenue. The totalitarians are up \$40 billion. Who, indigenous or foreign, wouldn't participate? Only the ethical and patriotic.

As a consequence, if ten percent of Canada's population (~3 million*) are street soldiers – concentrated in the country's main centers of economic power of Toronto, Montreal and Vancouver – and they voted the same way *en masse* as ordered by their superiors, then one would reasonably expect the rigged result the international community saw in the early 2006 federal election. Not a single riding in any of these three cities went to the Conservatives. As was confirmed in *The Art of War and How the Chinese Conquered the Last Democratic Fiefdom*:

When all the official statistics are tallied, there are 1,277,451 registered Chinese immigrants in the country.

Add a century to cultivate a following of indigenous Canadians, many of whom voting not for money but out of party loyalty, and it's easy to argue the street soldier community could be as large as 5* to 6 million.

The foregoing proves yet again how critically important it is for the Canadian lawyer to remain vigilant in recording and documenting coalition activity. The synergy between him and his coalition partners can only be effective if both work together on a regular basis. And to continue to do so will deliver the results everybody but the malfasant want: the end of the last democratic fiefdom.

As a result of a secret recruitment process that included most immigrants, including from China, and supplemented by domestic recruitment, there is now estimated to be 3 – 5 million people in the security apparatus that protects the consolidation of political power,

perpetuates the accumulation of wealth and maintains this secret sovereignty sharing arrangement.

'NBC Nightly News': Agreeing Incarceration is a Viable Solution to Punish Supporters and Financiers of Authoritarianism and Institutionalized Corruption in the Last Democratic Fiefdom

'NBC Nightly News': If It's War You Want, It's War You're Gonna Get

Immediately following the 'CBS Evening News' on September 19, 2006, NBC added another message – one to add to CBS stating Beijing and Canada's three sub-factions made a "big mistake" in challenging the United States.

For some two years, diplomacy was the principal mechanism to resolve the contentious issues between the coalition and the China-Canada military alliance. When it proved ineffective, a state of heightened diplomacy was called by the President – 'coercive diplomacy'. It too proved inefficacious.

The Power of the 'NBC Nightly News' Following the 'CBS Evening News', 'The Apprentice', 'Letterman', 'Leno' and CNBC to Suffocate the Last Democratic Fiefdom

It has become a daily routine of powerful proportions both for the Canadian lawyer and the Canada-Chinese elite to first watch CBS take round after segment round out of them, followed by the NBC team do the same for another half hour. By the end of it, he's elated and they're choked to the core of their sociopathic being.

Viacom's 'CBS Evening News' and the 'NBC Nightly News' have proven repeatedly their combined synergy in tag-teaming Canada's political and economic rot every single night now. And the finale is now the domain of that fantastic global community of co-anchors, experts and 'Wharton-Yale-Harvard' resources with CNBC's 'Worldwide Exchange'. The weekend is much the same. CNN is there to deliver massive doses of encouragement and body blows of condemnation; as is CBS and NBC on both days. Saturday night it's 'SNL'; and Sunday night it's '60 Minutes' and 'The West Wing'. The pressure is unrelenting and ubiquitous.
